

Cookie Present on www.dubbahood.com	Purpose of Cookie
AspNet.ApplicationCookie	Authentication cookie. This contains a token that allows the application to verify that the current user is a valid and authenticated user.
ARRAffinity	ARR uses a cookie to identify each user session. The cookie allows ARR to direct all the requests from each particular user to the same server instance (sticky session).
__RequestVerificationToken	The verification token embedded in the cookie ensures that the user submitting data to the site within a specific session is the same user who requested the web page in the first place. Protects the site from Cross-Site Request Forgery (CSRF). See http://blog.stevensanderson.com/2008/09/01/prevent-cross-site-request-forgery-csrf-using-aspnet-mvcs-antiforgerytoken-helper/
__utma	Used to distinguish users and sessions.
__utmb	Used to determine new sessions/visits
__utmc	Not used. Historically, this cookie operated in conjunction with the __utmb cookie to determine whether the user was in a new session/visit.
__utmz	Stores the traffic source or campaign that explains how the user reached the site.
